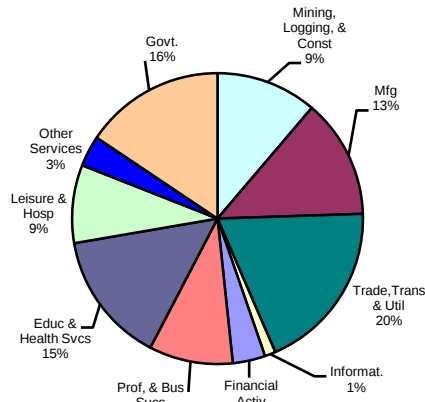
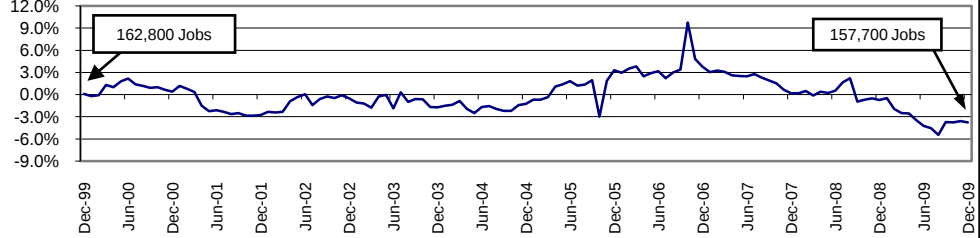


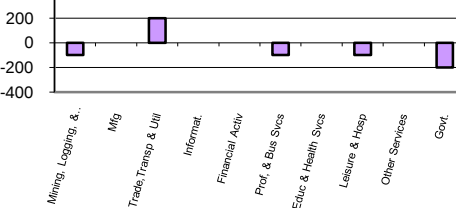
Industry Composition



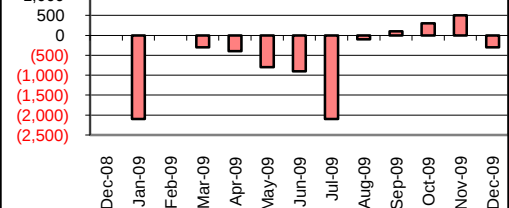
Annual Growth Rate for Total NonAgricultural Employment

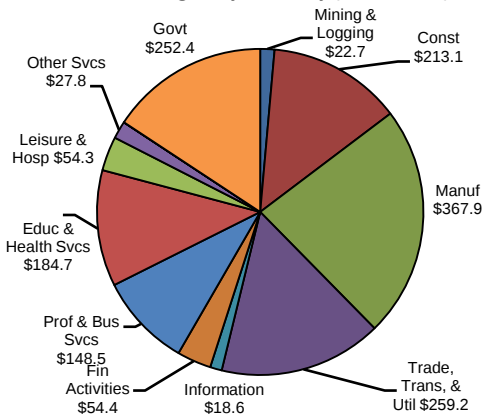

Comments for December 2009

Total Nonagricultural Employment in the Beaumont-Port Arthur MSA lost 300 jobs in December. This was the first loss following three consecutive monthly gains. Since December 2008, the MSA lost 6,100 jobs for an annual growth rate of -3.7 percent. Government lost 200 jobs for the month, following four months of over-the-month gains. State Government and Local Government contributed to the loss, dropping 100 jobs each. Leisure and Hospitality lost 100 positions for the second consecutive month. Since December 2008, the industry lost 400 jobs for an annual growth rate of -2.8 percent. Mining, Logging and Construction lost 100 positions. Retail Trade gained 100 jobs following two months of over-the-month increases. The annual growth rate for Retail Trade was -4.9 percent.
