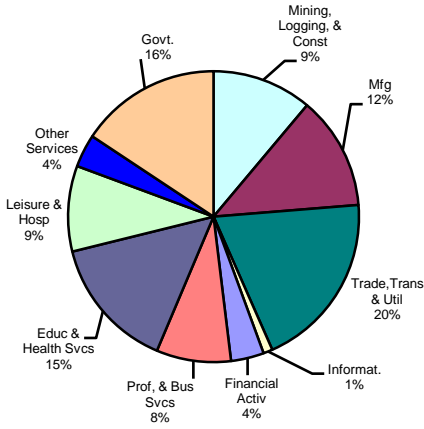
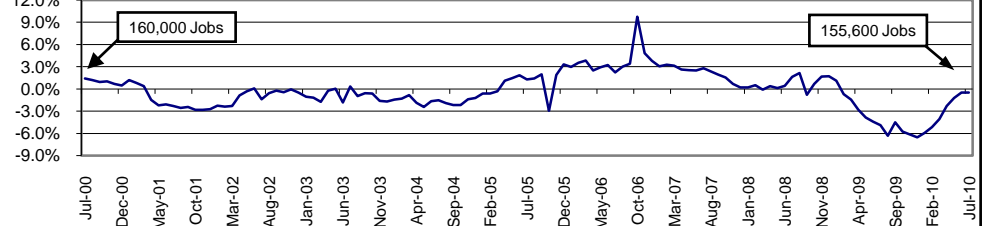


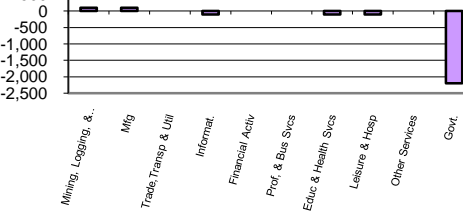
### Industry Composition



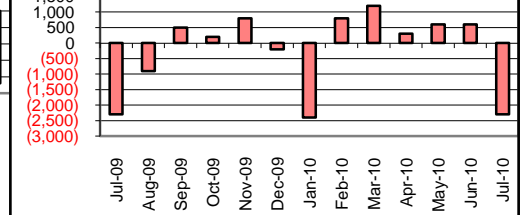
### Annual Growth Rate for Total NonAgricultural Employment

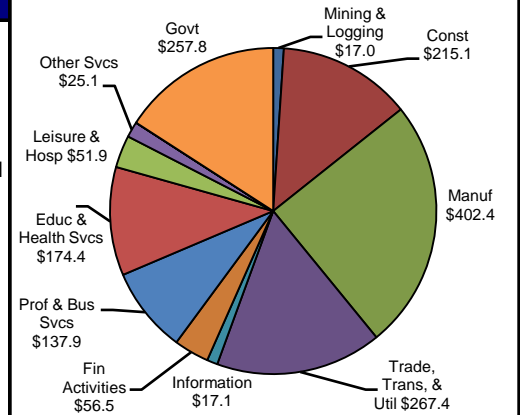

## Comments for July 2010

Total Nonagricultural Employment in the Beaumont-Port Arthur MSA decreased by 2,300 jobs in July. Since July 2009, the MSA lost 800 jobs or -0.5 percent. The majority of the decrease was in Government with a loss of 2,200 jobs. Local Government fell by 1,900 positions due to local school districts continuing to release staff for the summer break. Education and Health Services and Leisure and Hospitality had decreases of 100 jobs each. The Leisure and Hospitality loss followed five months of over-the-month gains. Slight decreases were reported in Retail Trade and Information. Mining, Logging, and Construction, Manufacturing, and Wholesale Trade increased by 100 jobs each in July.
