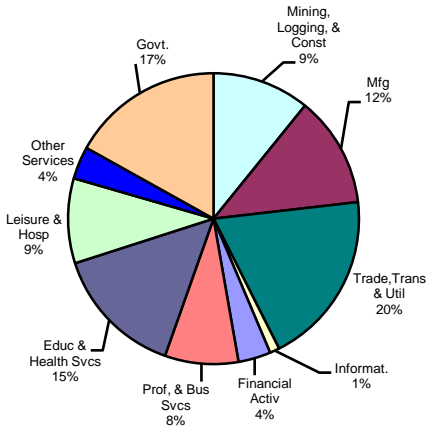
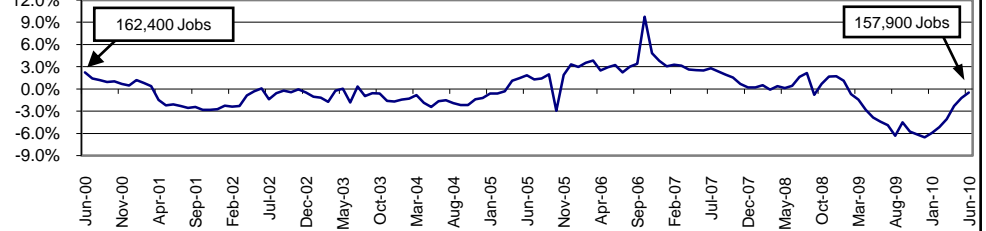


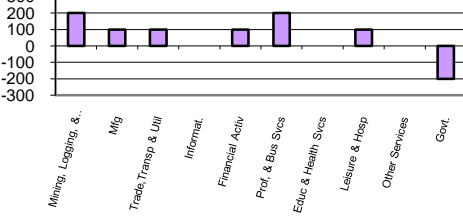
Industry Composition



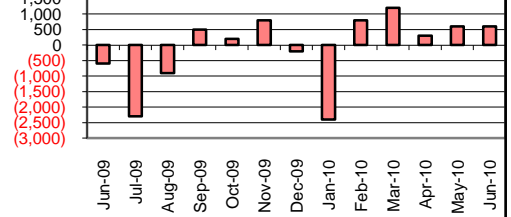
Annual Growth Rate for Total NonAgricultural Employment

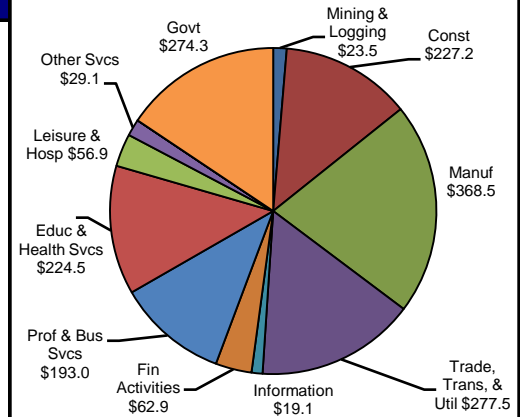

Comments for June 2010

Total Nonagricultural Employment in the Beaumont-Port Arthur MSA gained 600 jobs in June. Since January, the MSA gained 3,500 jobs. Mining, Logging, and Construction gained 200 jobs for June, marking the fourth consecutive month of gains for this industry. Since January, the industry gained 700 jobs. Manufacturing and Leisure and Hospitality contributed to the monthly gain with 100 jobs each. Since June 2009, Manufacturing lost 400 jobs for an annual growth rate of -2.0 percent. Leisure and Hospitality had an over-the-month growth for the fifth consecutive month. Slight increases were reported in Transportation, Warehousing and Utilities and Finance. Local Government lost 200 jobs for June, following an over-the-month increase in May.
